School Uniform Information UPDATED JUNE 2020

Students at Ramsgate Public School are asked to wear their uniform with pride and dignity and it is an expectation that the correct uniform is worn by all students every day. Wearing the uniform contributes to the school's identity, promotes loyalty among students and promotes a positive culture within the school and the community. This School Uniform Policy has been developed and reviewed with consultation between students, parents and staff and is endorsed by the P & C and SRC committee.

At Ramsgate Public School, we have a 'warm weather' and 'cool weather' uniform. There are no dates stipulated for a change in uniform; as long as students are appropriately dressed for the weather conditions and are in school uniform.

We also have a Sports Uniform which students wear on their Sport days.

Warm Weather Uniform

Boys:

- Bottle green short sleeve polo shirt
- Grey shorts (standard school type)
- Black shoes and grey socks
- School hat



Girls:

- Green Dobie check, A-line style with white Peter Pan collar, black zip and front button accent
- White short sleeve polo shirt with green shorts
- Black shoes with white socks
- School hat



Cool Weather Uniform

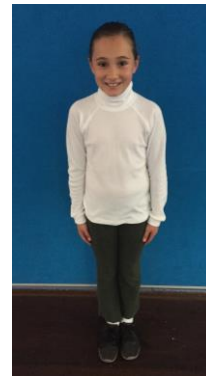
Boys:

- Bottle green long sleeve polo shirt
- Long grey trousers (standard school type)
- Black shoes with grey socks
- School hat



Girls:

- Bottle green tunic or tailored bottle green pants
- White skivvy or long sleeve white shirt
- Black shoes with white socks or green stockings
- School hat



Sports Uniform

Boys:

- Gold polo shirt
- Bottle green shorts or pants
- Sports shoes and white socks
- School hat



Girls:

- Bottle green shorts or pleated netball skirt
- Gold polo shirt
- Black or green scungies
- Sports shoes and white socks
- School hat



Jackets

Boys and Girls:

- Bottle green parasail jackets
- Bottle green zip up brushed cotton jacket
- Bottle green jumper



Hats

Students are required to wear hats on the playground at all time for sun safety.

This can be the bottle green cap or wide-brimmed hat with the school logo.



Please ensure that all items of clothing are labelled with the student's name

School Grooming Requirements

It is expected that all students will be well groomed and keep their hair clean and tidy.

Hair Length: Hair is to be kept neat and tidy. Hair length that exceeds the collar must be tied back and fringes are to be secured off the face if they reach below the eyebrows.



Hairstyles: Hairstyles that are deemed to be “way out” are not acceptable e.g. Mohawk style, checkerboard patterning, lettering or other noticeably exaggerated “fad” styles. Hair accessories are limited to unobtrusive adornments in school colours e.g. bands, scrunchies/elastics, clips and ribbons.

Jewellery: No body piercing other than a maximum of two studs or sleepers per ear is acceptable. Studs and sleepers may need to be removed in order to participate in some sporting activities. Safety requirements dictate that bangles, bracelets, earrings (other than studs or sleepers), necklaces, rings etc. are not permitted to be worn at school. Students may be requested to remove unsafe jewellery and the articles would be kept in a safe place until the end of the school day.
