# **Principal's Report – Lorraine Simmiss-Taylor**

Now with the open learning space they are the most modern. They are now flexible learning open spaces, unrecognisable from the old style of learning. Kids are so much more engaged. Debating is one of the components of shared knowledge with some 300 participants.
